FOREWORD

WHY ATTEND THIS CONGRESS?

Dear Radiologist,

The 12th Global Musculoskeletal MRI & Ultrasound Congress for Radiologists will be held from 1st-4th April 2020 at Holiday Inn Beach Resort, Penang Island, Malaysia.

Here are the key features of the Congress:

1. All radiologists will receive a chance to be tutored by senior Musculoskeletal Radiologists who are experts at Musculoskeletal Ultrasound. The practical session will start with a demonstration by the Musculoskeletal Radiologists in the first hour. Subsequently, each participant will be given 10-15 minutes initially to practise the technique shown by the faculty on the model until all participants in the group have attempted and been shown how to do the technique correctly. This is strictly monitored by an appointed group leader. After getting their hands-on practice, participants are free to move to any of the groups to observe, or go to the free tables with models to practice and ask any of the faculty members should they face any difficulties.

2. Faculty to participant ratio during the workshop sessions are kept small to enable quality hands-on ultrasound training. You will also get RCR UK 30 CPD points and for Malaysians 20 CPD core points for NSR renewal and APC renewal. There is plenty of time for hands-on practice as we have extra tables and models for each session. Please note that only limited places are available to enable personalized training. The advantage of this congress is that in four days you learn both MSK MRI and MSK Ultrasound. In today's MSK Radiology practice, you will find that MSK Ultrasound has taken a greater role in diagnosis of superficial tendon and ligament pathology.

3. If you attended the Global MSK Courses before the year 2018, kindly note that 150 new MSK MRI and MSK Ultrasound DICOM videos are now being shown during the MRI & Ultrasound video sessions to complement the lectures. The Ultrasound pathology using static images and videos will only be taught after the practical session. The abnormal images of pathology shown in the Musculoskeletal Ultrasound Video Session will then be easily appreciated as one has already been accustomed to seeing the normal appearance in the standard planes during the practical session. This will lead to a huge appreciation of pathology without the need for actual patients. Having the practical ultrasound training after the MRI Video session gives greater appreciation of bony landmarks and positioning of tendons and ligaments for each joint.

4. On the final day, I will be introducing a new addition to the congress programme. I look forward to sharing about my current experience and knowledge with Interventional joint injections from working as a Consultant Radiologist at Beverly Wilshire. Explanation of injectables and how they work, indications, techniques in detail and anatomic positioning of injection will be the focus of the final day. As a radiologist, after this congress you will be confident to provide this interventional service which is able to reduce the number of surgery on patients and also give you the opportunity to earn more doing procedures than by solely doing general reporting of MRI and performing MSK Ultrasound.

5. The focus of this congress will be on how we really solve problems in patients with MSK symptoms using one or other modality or both MSK MRI and Ultrasound. Participants will be taught which modality is better for which indication for accuracy of diagnosis. For instance, it is far more accurate to use Ultrasound for detection of ankle ligament tendon and ligament tears than MRI as these structures are very small on MRI and often not clearly visualised in the 3mm slices but seen very well on ultrasound and function can be tested with dynamic manoeuvres. Emphasis will be on how to grade residual function of a ligament which is what the Orthopaedic surgeon wants to know and also tendon pathology.

6. For the practical sessions, you will have a choice to be trained at Basic, Intermediate or Advanced Level. Basic level means you have not attended any Basic MSK Ultrasound course and are not doing MSK USS weekly. Intermediate level means you have attended a Basic MSK Ultrasound Course and are practising MSK ultrasound weekly on patients. Advanced level means you are highly experienced in MSK Ultrasound and would like more specific teaching of different joints.

7. We will provide each participant with a 16GB USB which will contain articles on all the major joints, reporting templates, MRI sequence protocols, MRI homework, Videos, Powerpoints, E-books, etc. Most of this material has been donated by previous lecturers and my fellows over the years. It has some of the best references to articles on particular topics over the last 10 years and forms part of the curriculum. Learning indeed continues well after the congress until you have read all the articles provided.

8. The congress enables a radiologist to report MSK MRI accurately for all common pathology as it concentrates on reporting 95% of common pathology well. Think about it, what is the point of knowing the course of the sural nerve when you can't even report ACL tears accurately? At the end of the congress, one can also perform basic MSK Ultrasound well and make diagnosis of main and common pathology of most joints. MSK Ultrasound often identifies the real cause of the patients' current symptoms rather than MRI which may be non-specific myriad of new or old abnormalities.

9. Opportunities for oral paper presentations are available. Kindly submit your standard abstract (not more than 250 words) to the Secretariat for consideration by the Scientific Committee. Further details will be provided following your submission.

10. For ease of registration fee payment, credit card payment options are available for overseas delegates. Upon online registration, you will be sent a credit card payment link for the amount due which will be valid for 7 days. It is advised that you register early if you are keen on joining the 2020 congress as places fill up fast.

11. We have negotiated for special room rates with Holiday Inn valid from 29th March-9th April 2020. The hotel booking form will be sent to you via email. Please fill it and send directly to the hotel as per instructions on the booking form. Kindly note that no commissions are taken by the conference organizers for room bookings to keep the room rates low. 1. Submit your abstract (of not more than 250 words) before 1st March 2020 for consideration by the Scientific Committee. Acceptance of your paper will be provided within a week of submission.
2. Please note that oral presentations are subject to slot availability and hence early submission of abstract is encouraged.
3. All oral presenters must settle their registration fees before the Congress.
4. The oral presentation session will be held during the tea breaks of the Congress. You will be informed of the day of your presentation via email two weeks before the Congress.
5. Presentation is to be allocated (8 + 2) minutes; unless otherwise specifically mentioned. The last "+2" minutes indicated is for discussion of your paper. The chairperson will alert the presenter at 6 minutes, to indicate that you have 2 minutes to end the presentation. Chairperson will request for questions from the floor and select audience members with questions. You are advised to adhere strictly to the time allocated to avoid disrupting the scientific
